1.	Minutes from the 10/14/19 meeting were approved.		
2.	The 12/02/19 agenda was approved.		
3.	Demonstration of Google Classroom: Teacher Josh Bayman showed examples of two students' google classroom home pages (identifying information not shown). He also enthusiastically demonstrated how the same assignment for two different students in a class can be easily differentiated and homework assignments can be posted. Classrooms that have been created for student events, self-assessments, and their uses were also discussed. Although Josh explained that more effort is required on the "front end", however google classroom has made teaching during class much easier and allows more time for instruction.		
4.	Update on Teacher Based Team Work: Teacher based team work is currently being led by Natalie Felty, the team leader who accompanied Heather Kronewetter to the John Hattie conference. This allows for teachers to work with a peer on "teacher efficacy" rather than these being "top down" decisions. This work is well underway as teachers have completed self-ratings, identified 4 learning dispositions to work on, and are forming "we" statements and "I can" statements which will eventually be put on posters and infused into the classrooms on a daily basis to create a schoolwide core philosophy that positively impacts learning.		
5.	Update on School Improvement Plan: A step was added to work on teacher efficacy prior to teacher clarity, approved by our sponsor, and uploaded into the system.
